

Washing Line Continuum on Water Issues

Read out a series of statements and have young people place themselves at different points on an imaginary line depending on the extent of their agreement or disagreement.

E.g. Standing at the very end of the line represents strongly disagree. Standing at the beginning of the line means strongly agree.

Statements to use:

Climate change is affecting the access to clean drinkable water around the world.

Our government can make a difference to global climate change.

Everyone should have the right to have access to clean water.

We cannot give people overseas clean water.

We will always have plenty of water so we can use it how we like.

The facilitator then invites people at different points on the line to give reasons for their answers.
